Targeted Services

We are developing a set of **targeted** interventions with **multi-dimensional** approaches to help specific groups. These interventions, combining assessment with group and individual work over time, are being developed in the light of evidence indentifying the considerable cost of keeping children in residential care and the potential value of targeted work which increases the likelihood of children being able to stay in or return to the home environment.

On the basis of this research we have identified a number of groups and scenarios which have a high risk of children being placed in care and for which we are able to offer multi-dimensional services in order to reduce that risk.

We are looking to collaborate with Local Authority agencies and commissioning teams to identify referral pathways and funding in order to implement targeted services for the following groups and more information on these projects is available from PCEA Ltd.

- Psychological intervention for Young Mothers
- Psychological Intervention for children who sexually abuse others
- Psychological intervention for children and young people with sexual behaviours
- Psychological Intervention for parents of children who exhibit challenging behaviours

Fee Structures

Expert Witness Assessments

Rates

Our rates are available on request and may vary according to the nature of the work, the experience of the practitioner, etc. All work carried out by fully qualified Chartered Clinical Psychologists for court and pre-proceedings assessments is charged for within the prevailing Legal Aid Authority (LAA) guidelines for hourly rates.

Hours

We also adhere to the LAA guidelines for maximum hours per person assessed and are happy to discuss fixing the maximum number of hours on a case by case basis.

Travel

We apply the LAA rates for travel which, at the time of publishing, is £40+vat per hour and 45p per mile.

Late cancellations and non-attendance

We reserve the right, as per LAA guidelines, to charge for all or part of the time allotted for an appointment if there is a non-attendance or cancellation with less than 72 hours notice. In practice, we would not generally implement this if warning is given with at least 48 hours notice and we make every effort to make only reasonable charges for time committed in the case of non-attendance and late cancellation.

Court attendance fees

Attendance at court is charged at the prevailing hourly rate and, per half day of attendance, includes 4 hours at court plus 1 hour review of report/documentation. Any additional reading or preparation is charged at prevailing rate.

Therapy

At the time of publishing this ranges from £80 – £100 per hour depending on qualifications and experience of therapist (exempt from VAT when carried out by a fully qualified Psychologist or Clinical Psychologist)

Edge of Care Assessments and other scenarios requiring reduced length reports

£90-100 per hour (exempt from VAT when carried out by a fully qualified Psychologist or Clinical Psychologist)
